


# Welcome Pack

### Registration

Registration for the event will take place in Jocelyn Bell Room which is located next to the porters lodge. Registration will open at 14:00 Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> September and will remain there throughout the event. If you need any help during your stay, please feel free to visit us in the Jocelyn Bell Room. You are also able to browse books and publications in this area and order the books that are of interest. A special offer for the event is free delivery to your preferred address with any purchase of a book. Lectures will take place in The Long Room and the Vivien Stewart Room which are located within this vicinity. You are able to help yourself to refreshments and lunch at breaks in the main corridor.

### Accommodation

If you are staying in University accommodation you can collect your keys from the porters' lodge (24hr). Check in is from midday Monday-Friday and 14:00 on Saturday and Sunday. **All rooms must be vacated** by 9am on departure day.

### Arriving by Road

From the M11, take junction 13 onto the A1303 towards Cambridge city centre.  
From the A14, take junction 31 onto the A1307 towards Cambridge city centre.

For our visitors, parking is available in our car park, off Storey's Way. If you are using a sat-nav, please use the postcode CB3 0DR/number 61.

### Arriving by Rail

Cambridge train station is around 2 miles away from Murray Edwards College.

There are regular trains from London, Birmingham and Norwich to Cambridge.

There are regular buses during the day with stops outside the train station that will take you to the city centre. From St. Andrews Street, take the Citi 5 or Citi 6 bus to Murray Edwards. Buses run every 20 minutes.

### Arriving by Air

London Stansted is the nearest international airport.


There are regular bus services by National Express from Stansted Airport to Cambridge Bus Station and they also operate bus services to all London international airports.

There are regular rail services connecting Cambridge to all London airports.
